- SUSF reserves the right to amend these Terms & Conditions from time to time.
- SUSF reserves the absolute discretion to terminate participation in the SUSF swim school at any time for any reason.

- If you require information regarding your child's progress please contact the Swim School Manager or Coordinators in person or by email.
- Due to time constraints and in the interest of all swimmers, if you would like to speak to an instructor or coach please email swim school and the information will be passed to them.

APPLICATIONS

- Application forms must be completed and signed by a responsible person or parent over the age of 18 years.
- All swim school participants, except preschool participants, must be assessed before joining any swim school program. For a free assessment please contact swimschool@sport.usyd.edu.au
- Places are subject to availability and at the discretion of SUSF.
- All relevant medical information must be declared at the time of application.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING

- No photography or video recording is permitted in the Sydney Uni Sports and Fitness Centre or Aquatic Centre.

PAYMENTS

- The Swim School programs operate in accordance with the NSW Public School Terms calendar.
- Term payments must be made in full at the time of enrolment. If payment has not been made admission to the lesson will not be permitted.
- All Squad fees are due on or by the 1st of each month to secure placement.
- All participants will receive a Swim School card that must be swiped at reception prior to each lesson to record attendance.
- Fees payable are subject to change at any time.

DISCOUNTS

- SUSF offer 5% discount for Learn to Swim participants who book 2 or more lessons per week.
- SUSF offer 5% discount for Learn to Swim participants siblings.
- Discounts cannot be combined.
- There are no other discounts available for any other programs offered by SUSF.
- The discounts offered are subject to change without notice.

CREDITS

- Requests for credits must be made by email to swimschool@sport.usyd.edu.au and will be at the discretion of the Swim Programs Manager.
- SUSF offer 2 complimentary make-up lessons per term
- Requests for make-up lessons may be requested after Week 3, and can only arranged one week in advance.
- Refunds will not be given for partial attendance of any lesson, nor will make-up lessons be provided.
- All make-up lessons are subject to availability
- In particular, SUSF cannot provide make-up classes for private/one-on-one lessons.
- Make up lessons must be completed in the term the classes were missed. No makeup lesson will be carried forward to the next term or holiday program.

SPECIAL NEEDS PROGRAM

- SUSF offers a Special Needs swim program for children who are assessed by SUSF as being unable to join a group lesson due to a disability.
- Special Needs classes are conducted on a one-on-one basis, and participants are offered a significant discount as compared to the usual rate for one-on-one classes.



- Given the discounted arrangement that applies to Special Needs classes:
- SUSF cannot guarantee the provision of one-on-one make-up classes

REFUNDS

All requests for refunds must be forwarded by email to swimschool@sport.usyd.edu.au

- Refunds will only be given if participants miss four or more lessons due to illness or injury. These requests must be supported by a medical certificate covering the entire period of claim.
- Refunds will also be granted to participants moving over 10km out of the area. Proof of new residential address must be provided. An administration fee of \$30 will be incurred for all refunds.

CONDITIONS OF POOL USAGE

- The health, safety and well-being of all participants and staff are paramount; all participants and parents should follow safety guidelines and instructions given by any member of SUSF staff.
- All participants must adhere to the SUSF Facility Code of Conduct. Breach of this Code may lead to termination of participation in the SUSF Swim Program. By completing and signing this application form you have read and understood the terms and conditions and the SUSF Facility Code of Conduct which is available on SUSF website www.susf.com.au
- Parents with children under 10 years of age must escort their children into the facility and remain with their child in view while the child is participating in lessons.
- Parents and guardians are expected to take full responsibility for their children upon entry to SUSF. SUSF does not take any responsibility for the supervision of children outside of their allocated swimming lesson. Swim School families are required to maintain appropriate behavior whilst within SUSF. All children must be supervised at all times outside swim lessons.
- SUSF reserves the right to refuse to allow participation of anyone suffering from or displaying symptoms of any illness including but not limited to contagious diseases. If your child is suffering from a contagious disease or infection please do not bring them to the facility. SUSF reserves the right to refuse entry to any child or adult.
- Swimming caps must be worn by ALL participants at all times during lessons and at all other times.
- To swim before or after any swim school program all supervising responsible persons, parents, caregivers and participants must be a SUSF member.
- Any person not enrolled in the swim school must pay the required additional fee to use the pool.
- No running is permitted around the pool area.
- No food and or glass bottles are permitted in the pool area.
- Appropriate swimming attire is required at all times. No clothes /underwear or loose, ill-fitting swim wear is permitted

RELEASE
