Travelling by bus? Catch 401, 402, 403, 404 from Strathfield or Lidcombe Station to Olympic Park Station.

Travelling by train? Catch trains from Strathfield or Lidcombe Station to Olympic Park Station.

Travelling by car? Remember to allow ample time for travel to the Venue. Peak hour traffic conditions will severely affect travel times. Park your car in marked spaces in the P2, P2 overflow car park, P3 or P4 parking stations. Then, before returning to your car after the event, get your parking ticket validated at the Aquatic Centre reception desk to receive 4 hours free parking. Nominated casual parking fees apply for parking over 4 hours.

Conditions of Entry

Entry fee is \$4 per person.

No ALCOHOL is allowed within the Venue. Venue security and event staff reserve the right to check bags and confiscate unsealed bottles on entry to the Venue.

Once inside the Centre, smoking is strictly prohibited. A number of receptacles are available outside the exit doors on the western side of the complex for smokers.

NO unauthorised diving is permitted off the diving boards.

All competitors and spectators are reminded that they are bound by Intercol and Sydney Uni Sport & Fitness' codes of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons will be removed from the Venue immediately by security and disciplinary action will follow.

All colleges must ensure that the venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the premises.

Competitors

All competitors are to use the competitors' change rooms between the Competition and Utility Pools on the western side of the Centre.

The conditions of entry to the Aquatic Centre allow for only recognised swimwear to be worn in the water. Articles of clothing such as T-shirts, casual shorts, bike pants or street clothes are unacceptable.

Each college will have 2 competitors for each event.

Each competitor may only compete in a maximum of 4 individual events and 2 relays.

Competitors are to report to the marshalling area for marshalling when called.

Each college may enter 2 relay teams in the freestyle relay. Each team is to be nominated before the races as "A" or "B". A and B freestyle relays will be run separately. B relay results will not contribute to official point scores.

2 referees will be judging all swimming events.

The diving area of the Utility pool has been reserved for competitor warm-up and cool-down during the carnival. This area will not be available to swimmers for such purposes during diving events.

Diving NSW judges are officiating all diving events. Divers are required to know what dives they are performing - 3 DIFFERENT DIVES, from 3 DIFFERENT GROUPS - so that score cards can be correctly completed for judging.
