COMPETITORS

All crews must stay to the right hand (bow) side of the warm up lake.
All crews may only enter the course when it is clear and safe to do so.
No row-throughs on the competition lake after 10am.

VENUE INFORMATION

Enter the venue via GATE A from Castlereagh Rd. Parking is free. Please park all vehicles in P1 and obey all signs. No cars are to be parked near the boatsheds or boat racks, other than those trailers with boats on.

Portable BBQ's are allowed on the Island, but not near the Regatta Kitchen and Bar.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Alcohol policy : the Regatta is a NO BYO event.
Spectators and competitors are NOT allowed on the Southern Bank of the venue, only the Island.

Bathing, wading or swimming in the lake is prohibited.

All colleges must ensure that the venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the venue.

All rowers and spectators are reminded that they are bound by Intercol and Sydney Uni Sport and Fitness' codes of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons will be removed from the venue immediately by security and disciplinary action will follow.

If any visitor carries out any of the listed prohibited activities, they will be asked to leave the venue immediately and may be reported to NSW Police.

Use of indecent, obscene, insulting or threatening languages or images;
Being intoxicated;
Being in possession of or under the influence of illicit drugs;
Behaving in an offensive or indecent manner;
Smoking;
Failing to comply with a reasonable request or direction from a Venue authorised person;
To drive, ride or park any vehicle including motor vehicles, bicycles or rollerblades on any grassed or landscaped area unless so directed by a Venue authorised person;
Interfering in any way with any habitat;
Throwing rocks into the lakes;
Standing on any seats within the venue;
Entering areas that are fenced off, locked or closed to the public;
Having any items made of glass - please note that (with the exception of in the restruant) the Venue is a glass free zone. Venue management reserve the right to check bags as a condition of entry.
