## 2013 INTERCOLLEGIATE SPORT REPORT

## GENERAL

2013 was an excellent year of intercollegiate sport from an administrative and competitive perspective. Key to the ongoing success of Intercollegiate sport are the continued support of SUSF clubs, the SUSF grounds department as well as an enthusiastic and supportive Intercol Committee, Council and college community. The logistics and operations of each event were good, with no major administrative issues experienced on the various match days. The Intercol community did face some significant challenges off the field in particular in regards to spectator behavior, which was managed by the Intercol committee, council and tribunal. The swimming carnival also had to be changed last minute due to the facility being double booked.

However, the overall level of competition between the colleges was extremely strong and tighter than seen in previous years. Congratulations to St. Andrew's College for winning both the Rawson and Rosebowl competitions for the fourth year in a row.

Other than the Rawson and Rosebowl sports, a number of social sports are played. AFL and Touch Football made a return in 2013 and the annual Sydney Uni Cricket Club (SUCC) XI v Intercol XI Twenty/20 Cricket match won by SUCC, continue to be successful events.

The year was rounded out with the Intercol Sports Dinner held at Wesley College. James Larkin (St. Andrew's College) was named Convenor of the Year for Tennis; Dani Lotzof (Women's College) was named Sportswoman of the Year; and Cameron Beech (St. John's College) was named Sportsman of the Year.

Recommendations for 2014:

- Provide appropriate First Aid coverage at ALL high impact events.
- Sport marshalls/representatives to be present at each event for monitoring and disciplining spectator behavior at events alongside the SUSF delegate, to be recommended and enforced by Intercol.
- Continue with the recommendation of fines on individuals and colleges for breaches of the Alcohol Policy or code of conduct at Intercol events.
- Increased promotion of and opportunities for social and participation focused sporting events.
