## GENERAL

2015 has been a successful year for Intercollegiate Sport both on and off the field. There were some excellent performances seen across many sports and certainly some up and coming athletes to look out for in the future. Given the number of challenges faced in 2014, it was great to see a number of changes that were implemented assisted with the overall running of events and helped to minimise negative impacts.

Congratulations to St Andrew's College for continuing their winning streak in 2015, retaining both the Rosebowl and Rawson cups. While Andrew's continue to be dominant in many areas, the competition in all sports remains strong with many challenging matches and contests that would have gone either way.

In addition to the regular Intercol sporting calendar, 2015 saw the revival of a social AFL tournament, organised by the Intercol Committee. While Touch Football and Cricket T20 were also on the social sport calendar, unfortunately these did not eventuate due to a number of reasons. Hopefully we can ensure that more social sport fixtures and promoted to college students next year to increase participation.

Unfortunately the culture of some events brings a certain amount of unnecessary and inappropriate 'banter' which, while often only involves a small number of students, can have detrimental impacts on the competition. It must be noted that the spectator incidents in 2015 were far less than recorded in 2014 which is a clear positive. The Intercol committee will continue to work on different initiatives in 2016 to continue to minimise this behaviour.

For the first year in some time, the Intercol Committee has finished the year with surplus funds in their events budget. This is largely due to the decreased cost of security at some venues, along with the unused Netball wet weather booking, which was kindly refunded. The Intercol committee has decided to roll the surplus amount over to next year's budget, to counteract some of the projected increases impacting the 2016 calendar.

The year was completed with a successful Intercol Sports Dinner held at The Women's College. It was great to have such an inspiring elite athlete in Melissa Perrine present to the students on the successes and challenges in her career, motivating those in the room, many of whom seek and will no doubt achieve further sporting triumphs at the elite level.

Operational changes made to College sporting events in 2015:

- Additional security at SUSF facility on Basketball finals evening due to incident in 2014.
- Basketball and Tennis order swapped around due to lack of availability of venue.
- Official referees and St John's First Aid used during social sport to minimise chance of injury.


## Recommendations for 2016:

- Continue to ban use of megaphones at sporting fixtures.
- Ensure senior student, Intercol representative or responsible allocated student is present from each college and fixtures to monitor their own college's behaviour and comments.

This is particularly important at those fixtures deemed to be close contests or traditionally large rivalry and negative banter.

- Ensure any negative banter is reported to SUSF representative immediately.
- Put in place guidelines for MC's at large events, (i.e. Swimming, rowing, athletics) to ensure professional commentary throughout events.
- Continue with use of official referees and St John's First Aiders in social sport where required (i.e. contact sports).
- Continue to use security for finals night fixtures where alcohol is banned and consumption can create negative outcomes

## Incident at Swimming:

- Competitors in relay B race - inappropriate swimwear worn by some male competitors.
- Inappropriate commentary by students on PA system.
- Scoring students confused some results of the timing system which led to some placings being recorded incorrectly.
- Incorrect lanes swam in during Rosebowl relays- students did not go to marshalling area and leading to flaw in overall results.


## Recommendations for 2015

- Compose rules for B-lane race swimwear and event. Compose restrictions/rules on commentators for all events that include commentary (Swimming/Rowing/Athletics).
- Ensure students marshal correctly and that student volunteers check correct lanes for all events, particularly relays.
- Encourage scoring student volunteers to arrive early to allow for more concise instruction from Swimming Australia officials.
- Get divers to prefill in their dive choices prior to event night to avoid delay
